

Fly America Act

(41 CFR Part 301-10)

- Government agencies and anyone receiving government grants are required to book travel on U.S. carriers or code-shares unless it is not possible.
- Abiding by the Fly America Act is not only AAAS policy, it is the law.
- You must fly a U.S. carrier or code-share for each leg of your journey.*
- AAAS does not honor the Open Skies Agreement

* There are a few exceptions that must be documented and approved by AAAS in advance.

Fly America Act – Exceptions

(41 CFR Part 301-10)

You must check at least one of the following statements to qualify for a waiver of the Fly America Act restrictions in this section:

_____ Use of a U.S. carrier increases the number of aircraft changes outside the U.S. by two or more.

_____ Use of a U.S. carrier extends travel time by six hours or more.

_____ Use of a U.S. carrier requires a connecting time of four hours or more at an overseas interchange point.

Fly America Act – Domestic

(41 CFR Part 301-10)

U.S. carriers include Alaskan Air, American, Delta, Frontier, Jet Blue, Southwest, United, etc.



Fly America Act – Foreign

(41 CFR Part 301-10)

Foreign carriers may be less expensive and may have more attractive itineraries. However, there are benefits to using an American carrier in the event of an emergency.

No matter how tempting, with U.S. government funds you may **ONLY fly U.S. carriers or code-shares!***

Fly America Act – Codeshare

(41 CFR Part 301-10)

What is a code-share?

It is a flight booked through a U.S. carrier that is operated by a foreign airline.

Example:

Delta Airlines flight XYZ, operated by KLM Airlines. Not KLM operated by Delta

Code-shares will be identified on the itinerary, receipt, and boarding pass.
